

- (a) Promoting, marketing, selling, offering for sale, advertising or hosting any seminars or events of any kind related in any way to the substance known as MMS, Miracle Mineral Solution, Miracle Mineral Supplement, or sodium chlorite or chlorine dioxide;
- (b) Promoting, marketing, selling, offering for sale, advertising, or manufacturing any substance, that is offered or intended to be used to treat a disease or condition of the human body unless the substance has been legally approved for such use as required by the Texas Food, Drug & Cosmetic Act, Tex. Health & Safety Code, Chapter 431;
- (c) Promoting, marketing, selling, offering for sale, advertising, or manufacturing of any substance intended to be used to treat a disease or condition of the human body that is adulterated or misbranded as defined in the Texas Food, Drug & Cosmetic Act, Tex. Health & Safety Code, Chapter 431.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if any provision of this Permanent Injunction is determined by to be unenforceable or void for any reason, that to the extent permitted by law, any other provision of this Permanent Injunction that is not affected by that determination shall remain in full force and effect.

The Parties shall bear their own costs and attorneys' fees.

This is a FINAL JUDGMENT in this cause and finally disposes of all parties and all claims. All relief not expressly granted herein is denied.

The Clerk of Court is directed to issue a writ of injunction.
